1 MYTH 1: “Reform UK is racist and far-right”

REALITY: Reform UK is a democratic party that welcomes members and candidates from all backgrounds and communities. In Redbridge, one of the most diverse boroughs in London, our candidates reflect the community they seek to serve. We believe in treating everyone equally, which means focusing on merit, fairness, and the issues that unite our community: safer streets, better housing, lower taxes, and accountable local government.

2 MYTH 2: “Reform UK will privatise the NHS”

REALITY: Reform does not propose privatising the NHS. The party supports a tax-funded, free-at-the-point-of-use health service. Reform’s proposals focus on cutting NHS bureaucracy, increasing frontline staffing, and reducing waiting times. At council level, Reform will push for better-funded social care to relieve pressure on local hospitals like King George.

3 MYTH 3: “Reform UK is a single-issue party that only cares about immigration”

REALITY: Reform has comprehensive local-government policies covering council-tax reduction, planning reform, housing delivery, public safety, and cutting bureaucratic waste. At local level, Reform councillors focus on the bread-and-butter issues that affect your daily life: bins, roads, parks, housing, and keeping your streets safe. Immigration policy is set at Westminster — your local Reform candidates are focused on making your council work better for you.

4 MYTH 4: “Reform will cut public services”

REALITY: Reform’s approach is to cut waste, not services. Redbridge Council spent nearly £40 million on temporary accommodation and has a £12 million SEND funding deficit. That is not efficient government, that is mismanagement. Reform will audit every council contract, eliminate wasteful consultancy spending, and redirect money to the front-line services you actually need.

5 MYTH 5: “Reform does not care about the environment”

REALITY: Reform supports practical environmental measures — cleaner streets, more trees, protecting green spaces like Hainault Forest and Fairlop Waters, and proper recycling services. What we oppose is wasteful virtue-signalling policies that cost millions but achieve nothing measurable. Reform councils across the country continue environmental work under practical, affordable frameworks — not undeliverable ‘net-zero by 2030’ targets that drive up costs.



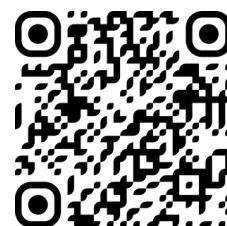
